**Due to the H1N1 Virus and the different flu that is going around this year, if your child is brought to the office, is running a fever and ill, they will be asked to wear a surgical mask until a parent has picked them up, but while in the school, this will be mandatory. This is for the protection of everyone involved. We would also like to encourage parents to purchase these masks for home to protect family members at home. This is not to create a scare but to eliminate the spread of any flu virus.**

**REMINDER – SAFETY ISSUE: Please remember that when the weather is foggy and/or rainy, it is best to have your headlights on for everyone to see.**

**REGULAR FLU SHOTS: the Center for Disease Control is highly recommending regular flu shots be gotten right away by all children ages six months to 18 years old and by all caregivers (teachers, parents, etc.). This is a precautionary measure and one of the reasons is because there is a 4 to 6 week interval between getting this shot and getting the swine flu shot when it is ready. You are urged to contact your health provider and get this set up as soon as possible. The Pawnee Clinic has also told us that you can go there to get a regular flu shot at a cost of about \$20.00. They are not recommending flu shots for the elderly at this time.**

If your child periodically takes medication such as a pain reliever for headache, the parent form needs completed and brought back to the school office.
