This is **NOT** the yellow permission form that was originally sent out from the school. This consent form was sent to you the day before Thanksgiving break. It says

“2009 H1N1 Influenza Vaccine Screening and Consent Form” at the top. If you DO NOT have that consent form—or have not already returned it—we have more of them available in the school office. You can stop in the office and fill one out—it will take you only a few minutes. A reminder that this flu shot is given free of charge. ALSO—if you would like to be here on December 9 while your child is receiving their flu shot, you are more than welcome. We will begin with the younger children at 9:30 a.m. and proceed from there.
